They manufacture steel components such as starter bases for tower cranes, collars and ties (secure the crane to the building), towers and other such equipment. They also provide rigging services to erect, climb and dismantle tower cranes.

GFB currently supply services to all the major tower crane suppliers in Melbourne. Both Graham Farmilo and Gavin Butler are contracted to stay with Verticon for a five year period.
